## Program Ideas

The following program ideas are offered for consideration by club officers and members. Each month's meeting(s) should address each area of focus - Leadership, Service & Education. Some ideas you may want to consider when planning a meeting include:

- Invite a guest speaker to address a particular topic. See Speaker Resources page on our website. You may want to consider inviting other clubs to join your meeting when you have a guest speaker to assure a good audience.
- Hold an informal debate/discussion - Select a topic. Assign members to different sides. Practice civility and respect when listening to and presenting your thoughts. Consider switching sides halfway through the meeting.
- Extemporaneous speaking - draw a topic from a hat and after 5 minutes present a 3 minute talk about your topic.
- Visit another club or invite them or their officers to your meeting to discuss common goals and how you can work together.
